### Meadow Way Workshop

A public workshop was held on November 20 to present information on the Meadow Way Bridge, and to gather public input. ## Upcoming Events

### Meadow Way – Upcoming Geotechnical Testing

On Tuesday, December 3rd and Wednesday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, the geotechnical team will conduct tests on site to further assess the geologic conditions at the Meadow Way Bridge. Tests consist of drilling a 4” diameter, 50’ deep boring into the ground at each end of the bridge. On completion of the tests, the holes are filled with grout.

One boring will be done on each of the two days, using a portable drilling machine. A small motor at the north end of the bridge will run constantly, powering the drill for both borings. Drilling will begin at 8:00 a.m. and will conclude no later than 5:00 p.m. In case of rain, drilling will be rescheduled.
