Update on Creek Road/Bridge Preventive Maintenance Program

A public workshop was held on January 29th at the Fairfax Women's Club. At the workshop, the potential replacement of Creek Road bridge was discussed. The engineering team's assessment report indicated that it is more cost effective for the Town to replace the bridge than to make seismic retrofit improvements.

Due to the low turnout at the workshop, Town staff decided that it would send a new fact sheet to the neighborhood indicating the possibility of replacement, and offering an opportunity to the residents to submit comments and questions via email, before the options are considered by the Town Council.

However, since the workshop, staff has met with Caltrans staff who indicated they will review the assessment report and let us know if they agree with the assessment and, more importantly, if there is funding available for replacement, even if it is deemed a more cost-effective solution.

Caltrans' determination will dictate whether replacement of the Creek Road Bridge is a viable option for consideration. As a result, the project is in a "holding" pattern until Caltrans can complete its review (4-6 weeks).
